Dear residents,

I'm sure you are aware of the spread of COVID19 otherwise known as the coronavirus. As with any public health situation awareness, sensible preparation, and prudent measures are key.

Our staff is monitoring the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations for the coronavirus. The CDC has a website we recommend using as a guide for pertinent information regarding the coronavirus [here](#).

The CDC recommends the following actions to help prevent the spread of all respiratory diseases:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Stay home when you are sick and seek medical assistance if needed
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash
- Clean and disinfect frequently-touched objects and surfaces
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
 - If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
